1. What is a Mini-Course?

A Mini-Course is a short, online course (one month long maximum), led by a qualified instructor. It contains 25 hours of high-quality professional development.

2. Where is the Mini-Course being held?

3. What Qualification/Certification will I receive?

Upon successful completion you will receive a certificate of completion. This **cannot** be used for salary considerations because this is a non-accredited course. These courses are meant to give teachers the know-how to make life easier in the classroom.

4. What is the cost and what is the Refund Policy?
